## Four days a legionary should not let pass

- **8 September** · The Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary — Our Lady's birthday — and the feast the Legion keeps as its own
- **12 September** · The Most Holy Name of the Blessed Virgin Mary — her name kept as her Son's is kept in January
- **15 September** · Our Lady of Sorrows — the day after the Cross is lifted up, the Church turns to the woman who stood beneath it
- **24 September** · Our Lady of Ransom — Our Lady of Mercy — kept devotionally rather than on the Irish calendar; the title the Legion first bore
